GETTING STARTED

Wake up your remote

Insert two AAA batteries (included). Turn on by pressing any button. It may take 5-10 seconds to wirelessly connect to your bed. While searching for your bed, or if out of range, it will display **b.t.** Keep within 8 feet of the bed when using.

Turn on Responsive Air®

Responsive Air® is designed to sense your movements and automatically adjust to keep you sleeping comfortably through the night. To enable or disable this feature, hold down the L/R button for 3 seconds or until the indicator turns on or off.

Find your Sleep Number® setting

It's normal for your Sleep Number® setting to be different from what you found at a store, and for your setting to change over time. Here's how to adjust to your ideal comfort and support, whenever you like.

- Begin by lying on the bed in your preferred sleeping position.
- The L/R button lets you select and adjust either side. This button is non-functional on single chamber beds.
- Choose your side, Left/Right as indicated on the display, as though you are lying on your back on the bed.
- Use the Up/Down arrows to increase or decrease the firmness of your mattress.
- Start at the firmest setting (100) and then decrease the softness until you feel comfortably supported — your Sleep Number® setting.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Pair a remote

(if purchased separately)

- If display shows **P**, then it is already searching to pair with a bed. Unplug your bed for 10 seconds, then plug back in. Within 30 seconds, the remote will pair to the bed and begin displaying the Sleep Number® setting screen.
- To pair the remote to a new bed, simultaneously press the UP and DOWN buttons for 5 seconds or until the display shows **P**. Then repeat the steps above to pair to a new bed.

Using two remotes

- Your bed will allow up to two remotes to connect simultaneously. When one remote is adjusting to a Sleep Number® setting and a second remote attempts to adjust the other side of the bed, the first adjustment will be canceled while the second will proceed.

Replacing batteries

- When you see the low battery symbol on your display, you'll need to replace your batteries within a few weeks. If it's been too long, the remote will remain asleep when you try to wake it up.
